

Executive Summary:

The project will offer fellowship support for two graduate students to pursue education and careers in the nuclear engineering field. Students who are awarded Fellowship will receive a full tuition waiver and a stipend of \$25,000 per calendar year. Up to two fellowships shall be awarded per year, over four years. The project is intended to develop and maintain the nuclear workforce by promoting two important goals. Firstly, by supporting new graduate students, the fellowship will encourage advanced training and experience for those entering the nuclear field. Secondly, the fellowship opportunities will increase the interest in nuclear engineering graduate study, leading to a greater number and diversity of those being trained in nuclear technology.
