

## **The Faculty Development Program at the University of Tennessee**

### **Executive Summary**

The Faculty Development Program at the University of Tennessee (UT) will support four junior faculty members recently employed in the Nuclear Engineering Department. The project will be administered by the PI, Dr. H. Lee Dodds, Professor and Head of the Nuclear Engineering Department.

This budget includes the support for developing research proposals, new course development, equipment and materials stipends, participation in professional society meetings, the preparation of papers, travel, and other startup costs. The objective of this program is to develop the targeted faculty members to achieve excellence in both research and teaching and then to retain them. The benefit of this program to the University and to the nation will be an enhanced capability of the Nuclear Engineering Department to meet the nation's need to train a new generation of nuclear engineers and health physicists.
