

Executive Summary:

The Department of Nuclear Engineering and Radiation Health Physics at Oregon State University will administer the NRC Scholarship Program over a period of two years, awarding scholarships of \$6,000 each to ten (10) highly-deserving students every year, maximizing the return on NRC funding. Awardees will be honored at our Spring Departmental Colloquium. Dr. Abdollah Farsoni, Assistant Professor and Chair of the NE/RHP Departmental Graduate Committee, will administer the scholarship program. As a result of maximizing the number of recipients, the NRC will benefit by bringing 20 highly-skilled engineers/health physicists/radiochemists from the Pacific Northwest into the NRC workplace and preparing them for a career in nuclear-related fields. Award recipients will be selected from a pool of applicants taken from the rising junior and senior classes. Only the best and brightest of our rising senior class will be considered for this prestigious award.
