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NRC SCHEDULES FOURTH WORKSHOP ON DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE WITH CLEANUP CRITERIA

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has scheduled the fourth and last in a series of workshops on methods for demonstrating compliance with its recently issued regulation on radiological criteria for license termination.

The workshop will be held February 18 and 19, beginning at 9 a.m. and ending at about 5 p.m. each day, in the NRC's auditorium at Two White Flint North, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland.

Purpose of the workshop is to receive input from the public and licensees on working papers the NRC is developing on (1) methods for conducting a final radiological survey and (2) dose modeling--mathematical formulas for calculating the expected radiation dose under site-specific conditions.

The working papers, which have received only limited NRC staff review, are being developed as part of a future NRC regulatory guide on "Demonstrating Compliance with the Radiological Criteria for License Termination."

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
