Dear Mr. Chairman:

In accordance with P.L. 107-67, Sec. 630. (e), this letter constitutes the required notification that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) intends to continue implementing a child care tuition assistance service for its lower income employees. The Commission allocated \$25,000 for this purpose for Fiscal Year 2007, to be used to provide child care subsidies for employees throughout the agency if their total family income is \$55,000 per year or less. Qualifying employees will be eligible for tuition assistance ranging from 10 percent to 50 percent of their child care costs, depending on family income and actual child care costs, with an annual maximum of \$4,000 per family.

The NRC welcomes this opportunity to assist its lower income employees in meeting their professional and family obligations.
