TRAINING: Training for IMC 0609 App A has been provided to the Senior Reactor Analysts (SRAs) at the last two SRA counterpart meetings. The SRAs provided training to the region-based and resident inspectors. This training was completed in 10/2006.

Training for IP 71111.01 and IP 71111.13 was performed at the Resident Inspector Counterpart Meetings and completed on 12/13/2006.

REMARKS: IMC 0609 App A (Determining the Significance of Reactor Inspection Findings for At-Power Situations) has been revised to incorporate references to the site-specific inspection notebooks and associated Pre-Solved Tables. In Attachment 2, the site specific risk-informed inspection notebooks usage rules were updated. In Attachment 3, user guidance for screening of external events risk contributions is provided.

IP 71111.01 (Adverse Weather Protection) has been revised to address feedback from 71111.01-902 to include recommended inspection guidance and also, to incorporate inspections for the offsite power system and the alternate AC power source.

71111.13 (Maintenance Risk Assessments and Emergent Work Control) has been revised to incorporate inspections for the offsite power system and the alternate AC power source.
