FY 2005 CONTRACT COMMITMENT

The increase in funding results from a contract commitment to produce a video about NRC for the Office of Public Affairs. Funds were certified as available for this contract during FY 2005, but the contract was not awarded until after the end of the fiscal year. These funds are part of the NRC's FY 2005 unobligated funds carried forward into FY 2006 and have been reallocated for obligation to this contract.
