**MEETING REPORT

PURPOSE: Discuss R.M.D Operations, LLC's (RMD's) current and future licensing activities.

**BACKGROUND:**

RMD possesses a license to establish ion exchange (IX) treatment systems at potable water treatment plants to remove uranium to below the 0.03 mg/l U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) drinking water standard.

**DISCUSSION:**

Following introductions, RMD presented the locations of its various treatment plants throughout the U.S. RMD removes radium (not regulated by NRC), as well as uranium. RMD stated that compliance with the EPA's drinking water standard was not mandatory until January 2008. Also, RMD stated that it is looking at various disposal options, including licensed radioactive waste disposal sites, existing uranium mills, and existing *in situ* leach (ISL) sites.

RMD understands that license amendments are required to dispose of the IX resins at uranium mills or ISLs. However, these facilities have been slow to apply for such amendments. RMD understands that the NRC is not the sticking point in this process.

After the business portion of the meeting, questions were received from members of the public. Answers were provided by NRC staff.
