SUBJECT: SCOPING SUMMARY REPORT RELATED TO THE  
ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING PROCESS FOR THE CALVERT  
CLIFFS UNIT 3 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION REVIEW

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted its scoping process from February 14 - April 14, 2008 to determine the scope of the NRC staff's environmental review of the combined license application for the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant Units 3 (CCNPP). As part of that process, the NRC held two public scoping meetings in Solomons, Maryland on March 19, 2008, to solicit public input regarding the scope of the environmental review.

The NRC staff has prepared the enclosed Scoping Summary Report which identifies comments either received at the public scoping meeting, by letter, or by electronic mail and provides responses to those comments. In accordance with 10 CFR 51.29(b), participants of the scoping process who provided contact information will be provided with a copy of the scoping summary report. The transcripts of the scoping meetings are publicly available in the NRC Agencywide Documents and Management System under accession numbers ML081160460 and ML081160468.

The next step in the environmental review process, contingent on receiving all necessary information, is the issuance of a draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), currently scheduled for early 2009. Notice of the availability of the draft EIS and the procedures for providing comments will be published in an upcoming *Federal Register* notice.
