5. The Performance Objective for Classified/Sensitive Unclassified Waste found in the Performance Work Statement (PWS) is hereby revised as follows:

Performance Objective: The Contractor shall empty classified/sensitive unclassified waste containers at all NRC Headquarter locations, which currently includes but is not limited to the following: White Flint Complex, NRC Warehouse, Executive Boulevard Building, Gateway Building, Twinbrook Building and Church Street Building. The Contractor shall dispose of material in an approved manner using the document disintegrator located at the TWFN load dock or take the material to an approved destruction facility, as directed.

The Performance Measures, Disincentives, and Surveillance Plan shall remain unchanged.

6. The current contract ceiling through Option Year #1 is hereby increased by ~~\$704,262.00~~ from ~~\$7,535,923.00~~ to ~~\$8,240,185.00~~. The total contract ceiling is hereby increased by ~~\$3,521,877.00~~ from ~~\$20,999,390.00~~ to ~~\$24,521,267.00~~.
7. Funding in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 is hereby obligated. Funds are increased by \$2,000,000.00 from ~~\$4,106,162.00~~ to \$6,106,162.00.
8. The attached Section - B - Continuation Block dated February 11, 2009 is hereby incorporated into the contract. This document hereby replaces the previous Section - B of Modification #1 in its entirety.
