Dear Freedom of Information / Open Records Officer:

Pursuant to the Federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and all other applicable state and federal statutes, we request from your department / agency (and all divisions and agencies under your jurisdiction), all publicly available documents including, but not limited to:

- Any and all records of communication (including but not limited to letters, written requests, reports, telephone records, electronic communication, complaints, investigations, violation and memos) between your department (and all divisions and agencies under your jurisdiction) and the following individuals:

1) Mitchell Elias "Mitch" Daniels, Jr., or his offices for the following dates:

- 2005-Present, when Daniels was Governor of Indiana
- 2003-2001, when Daniels was director of the U.S. Office of Management & Budget
- 1990-2001, when Daniels was senior executive of Eli Lilly & Company
- 1977-1982, when Daniels was chief of staff to U.S. Senator Richard Lugar
- 1971-1976, when Daniels was an employee of Indianapolis Mayor Richard Lugar

2) Piyush "Bobby" Jindal, or his offices for the following dates:

- 2007-Present, when Jindal was Governor of Louisiana
- 2005-2008, when Jindal was a member of the U.S. House of Representatives, LA-CD1
- 2003-2001, when Jindal was Assistant Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services
- 2001-1999, when Jindal was president of the University of Louisiana System
- 1998, when Jindal was executive director of the National Bipartisan Commission on the Future of Medicare
- 1996-1998, when Jindal was Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health & Human Services

3) Sarah Louise Palin, or her offices for the following dates:

- 2006-2009, when Palin was Governor of Alaska
- 2003-2004, when Palin was chair of the Alaska Oil & Gas Conservation Commission
- 1996-2002, when Palin was Mayor of Wasilla, Alaska
 - 1999-2002, when Palin was president of the Alaska Conference of Mayors
- 1992-1996, when Palin was a city council member for Wasilla Alaska

4) Timothy James Pawlenty, or his offices for the following dates:

- 2003 -current, when Pawlenty was Governor of Minnesota
- 1993-2002, when Pawlenty was Minnesota State Representative, District 38B
- 1990-1992, when Pawlenty was an Eagan City Council member
- 1988-1989, when Pawlenty was chair of the Eagan Planning Commission

5) John Randolph Thune, or his offices for the following dates:

- 2005-Present, when Thune was U.S. Senator from South Dakota
- 2002-2004, when Thune was a lobbyist for Dakota, Minnesota & Eastern Railroad

- 1996-1993, when Thune was a member of the South Dakota Municipal League
- 1991-1993, when Thune was South Dakota Railroad Director
- 1986-1989, when Thune was an appointee of President Reagan for the Small Business Administration
- 1985-1986, when Thune was an aide to U.S. Senator James Abdnor

6) Michael Dale "Mike" Huckabee, or his offices for the following dates:

- 2003-2007, when Huckabee was Governor of Arkansas

7) Willard Mitt Romney, or his offices for the following dates:

- 2003-2007, when Romney was Governor of Massachusetts

- Any and all freedom of information requests filed with your department / agency (and all divisions and agencies under your jurisdiction) mentioning the aforementioned Mitchell Daniels, Piyush Jindal, Sarah Palin, Timothy Pawlenty, John Thune, Michael Huckabee or Willard Romney.
- If this request would generate a substantial number of documents, we would prefer to have an index of the documents. Of course, this request for an index does not preclude us from later requesting any or all of the documents included in the index. Additionally, we request that the information we seek be provided, if possible, in an electronic format via a personal computer disk or CD-ROM.

We understand that there might be costs associated with this request. We request a waiver of fees and ask for you to contact either of us by telephone before making copies if this request will be in excess of \$25.

We would appreciate your communicating with us by email at dncoia@gmail.com or by telephone at (202) 412-4831, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request. If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption which you believe justifies your refusal to release the information and inform us of your agency's administrative appeal procedures available to me under the law. We look forward to your reply within 20 business days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays), as the statute requires.
