Below is from today's "NRC in the News" - just in case you didn't know.

NRC To Host Two Public Meetings On Shieldalloy's Decommissioning Plan. The Vineland (NJ) Daily Journal (11/19, Smith) reports, "Federal officials will hold back-to-back public meetings on a plan to store radioactive material today and Thursday at Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corp." NRC "officials will ask for updates on Shieldalloy's plan to decommission its operation," and is "budgeting a total of six hours of meeting time to the topic, including time for residents to speak. The heart of the decommissioning, and the sole topic of the initial meeting this afternoon, is disposing of thousands of tons of radioactive industrial waste." The Daily Journal adds, "A second meeting Thursday afternoon will focus on multiple issues, including Shieldalloy's analysis of radiation safety issues and cost factors in closing the facility. NRC spokeswoman Diane Screnci said the meeting could result in the commission sending more requests for information to the company. NRC spokesman Neil Sheehan said the bulk of these two meetings will be dedicated to commission officials and Shieldalloy representatives. The public then gets to ask questions."
