PURPOSE: To inform the residents and interested stakeholders in the area of the US Ecology Disposal Facility in Grand View, ID of (1) Westinghouse Electric Company's request to amend the Hematite license (NRC ADAMS No. ML100700619) to permit disposal of low-activity radioactive materials in the form of building rubble from the Hematite Decommissioning Project at the US Ecology Facility and that US Ecology be exempt from the requirements of 10 CFR 30.3 and 10 CFR 70.3 which require entities which possess byproduct and special nuclear material, respectively to possess a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license and (2) the NRC process which allows interested parties to request a hearing. License No. SNM-00033 (Docket 70-0036).
