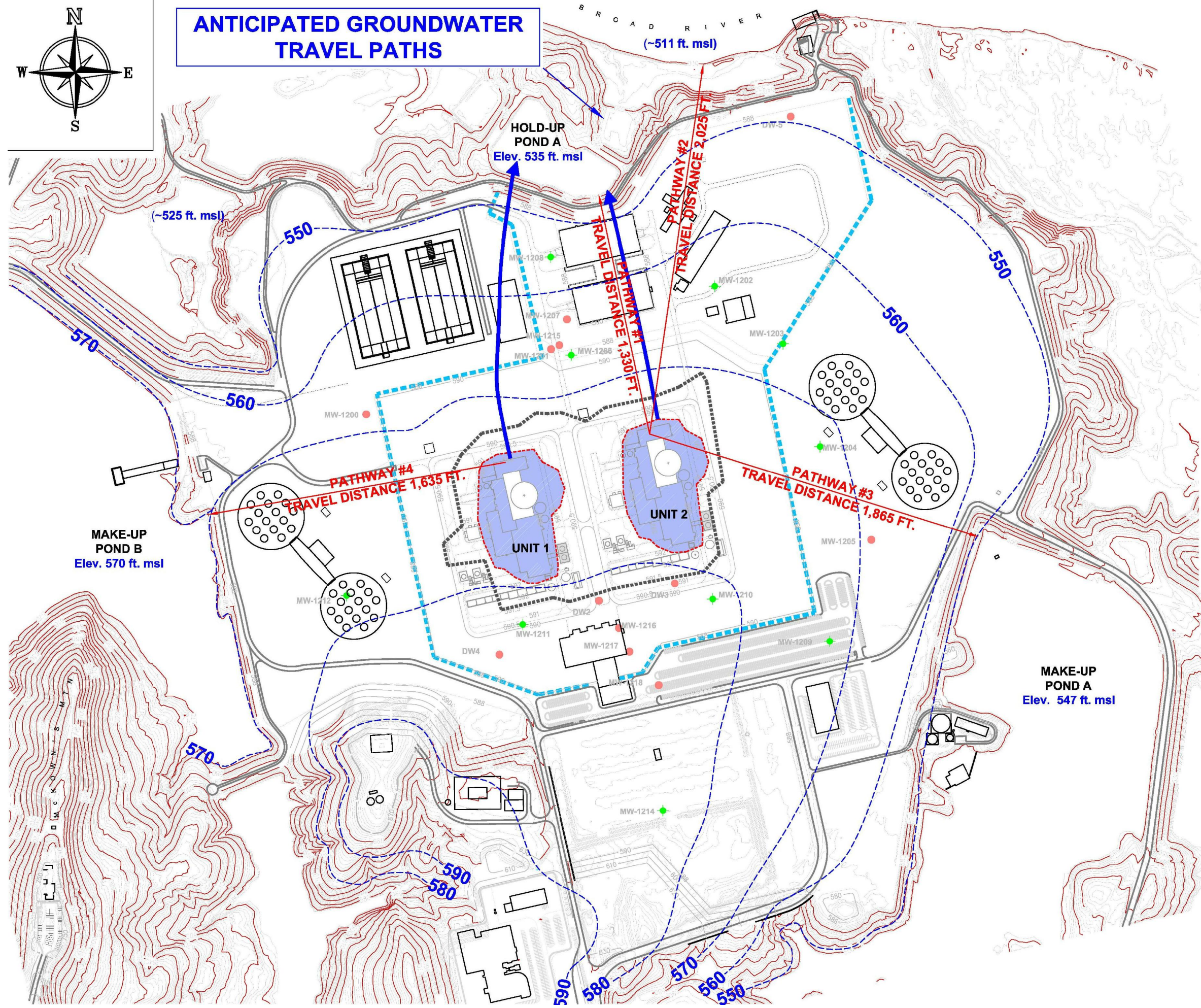
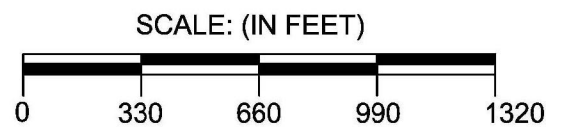
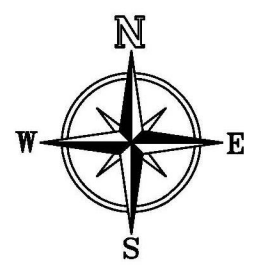


ANTICIPATED GROUNDWATER TRAVEL PATHS
