Dear Mr. Henry:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region II and Headquarters staff completed a program adjustment review of the Nuclear Fuel Services' (NFS) performance in conducting NRC licensed activities. In accordance with Inspection Manual Chapter (MC) 2604, "Licensee Performance Review," the program adjustment review provides an opportunity for adjustments to the inspection program to reflect emergent performance issues that may reveal themselves during the normal 24-month performance assessment period.

The review covered the period January 1 through December 31, 2013. The performance of NFS was evaluated in the following areas: Safety Operations, Radiological Controls, Facility Support, and Other Areas. This letter provides to you the results of our review, and constitutes the basis for establishing the NRC oversight program for your facility. The details regarding the Safeguards portion of the review are documented in a separate letter marked "Official Use Only" due to the sensitive nature of the information.

Overall, the staff determined that NFS has continued to conduct its activities safely and securely, while protecting public health and the environment. Based on our review of activities covering the period January 1 through December 31, 2013, no Area Needing Improvement was identified. Therefore, the NRC will conduct the core inspection program for a Category I Fuel Facility as described in NRC Inspection Manual Chapter 2600, "Fuel Cycle Facility Operational Safety and Safeguards Inspection Program," for the period of January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

In addition to the core inspection program, the NRC will be conducting supplemental inspections as necessary to confirm compliance with the requirements of the 2010 Confirmatory Order (ML103210221). The additional inspections will be conducted to evaluate the June 2013 Safety Culture survey results and completion of the order commitments.

The staff is continuing efforts to assess Unresolved Item 2012-006-01 to ensure compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 70 regarding accident sequences and potential consequences associated with natural phenomena events.
