



**SECY-11-0003, "Status of Enforcement Discretion Request and Rulemaking Activities  
Related To 10 CFR Part 26, Subpart I, Managing Fatigue"**

I appreciate Commissioners Apostolakis' and Ostendorff's support for use of an accelerated limited scope rulemaking to provide an alternative requirement to the non-outage minimum days off requirements in 10 CFR Part 26, Subpart I.
