The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has reviewed and does not object to the proposed subsequent arrangement to retransfer 3,439.377 kilograms of U.S.-origin uranium and 255.086 kilograms of plutonium from Japan to the Euratom Supply Agency. We understand that the transfer of this material will be subject to the same conditions as in the original transfer of the material from Euratom to Japan, including the shipment by sea pursuant to the Security Plan prepared by the UK and Japanese authorities and approved by the U.S. Government.
