Performance Evaluation Program

- Systematic review to identify significant:
 - -Operational performance trends
 - -Licensee performance issues
 - -NRC program issues/gaps

Performance Criteria

- Strategic outcomes
- Performance measures
- Abnormal occurrences
- Significant enforcement actions
- Trending review of event data

Strategic Outcomes & Performance Measures

- All strategic outcomes were realized
- Safety performance measures were met
- Security performance measure was exceeded by one occurrence



Abnormal Occurrences

- 23 AOs in FY 2011
- Number of AOs are small compared to number of uses with radioactive material
- No significant performance trends were identified

Review of Abnormal Occurrences

- Performed a study to examine a trend in the number of abnormal occurrences
- No significant trends identified when looking at actual date of abnormal occurrence

Licensee and NRC Program Performance

- No significant trending issues
- No NRC program gaps or failures



Industry Trends Program


- Industry-level performance trends
- Objective thresholds for action




BRIIE-LOOP category exceeded prediction limit



 Potential to exceed short-term prediction limit



 No long-term significant adverse trends



- LOOP events do not represent declining industry performance
- Proposed revision to Station Blackout Rule (NTTF Recommendation 4.1)

- No other indicators notable
- Significant Accident Sequence Precursor evaluation
- No program adjustments recommended

ROP Self-Assessment

- Reviewed against program goals
- Met performance goals and achieved intended outcomes
- No specific commitments from CY 2011 self-assessment

2012 Focus Areas

- Reintegrate security into ROP assessment program
- Engage stakeholders on potential enhancement to Public Radiation cornerstone
- Finalize common language for Safety Culture for power reactors

Action Matrix Deviation and Licensee Performance

- No new deviations in 2011
 - -Closed Vermont Yankee that was opened in 2010
- Result of operating reactor licensees discussion


