The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff on Reactor Licensing Initiatives. The Nuclear Energy Institute also provided comments.

The Commission understands that the number of Confirmatory Action Letters (CALs) has trended down over the past 10 years. The staff should provide the data on the number of CALs that have been issued each year for the last 10 years for Part 50 licensees and materials licensees.
