I. SECY-06-0216 - Pacific Gas & Electric Co. (Diablo Canyon ISFSI), Docket No. 72-26-ISFSI, "Motion by San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace, Sierra Club, and Peg Pinard for Partial Reconsideration of CLI-06-23"

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a motion by San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace seeking Commission reconsideration of the Commission's denial in CLI-06-23 of a motion for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief with Respect to Diablo Canyon ISFSI. The Memorandum and Order denies San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace's motion for reconsideration. Commissioner Jaczko has included a separate opinion, concurring in part.

II. SECY-06-0218 - System Energy Resources, Inc. (Early Site Permit for Grand Gulf ESP)

The Commission approved an Order responding to an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's October 17, 2006 Notice (Change in Schedule). The Order directs that the Commission will consider itself the admissibility of a recently filed late contention raising the issue of whether the Environmental Impact Statement must analyze the impacts of terrorism on the proposed facility. Commissioner Jaczko has included a separate, concurring opinion.
