Madam Secretary, why don't you 5 6 proceed? 7 MS. VIETTI-COOK: Okay, the Commission is being 8 asked to act on a final rule amending 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix K, Emergency Core Cooling System Evaluation Models, 9 to facilitate small but cost-beneficial powerup rates for 10 some commercial nuclear power plants. 11 The Commission has voted to approve the 12 13 publication and implementation of this final rule, subject to the attached comments. Would you please affirm your 14 15 votes. 16 [Chorus of ayes.] 17 MS. VIETTI-COOK: Next item, the Commission is 18 being asked to act on a memorandum and order responding to a petition submitted by Nuclear Information and Resource 19 20 Service to intervene in the license transfer application for 21 the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station. 22 The Commission has voted to approve a memorandum 23 and order which concludes that NIRS has demonstrated 24 standing; that NIRS issues are not admissible, denies NIRS' 25 request for hearing, and petition to intervene, and 4 1 terminates the proceeding. Would you please affirm your 2 votes? [Chorus of ayes.] 3 MS. VIETTI-COOK: The last matter is on Moab Mill 4 Reclamation Trust. The Commission is being asked to act on 5 a memorandum and order responding to Mr. John F. Darke's 6 7 request for a hearing. 8 The Commission has voted to approve a memorandum 9 and order which denies Mr. Darke's request for a hearing and terminates the proceeding. Would you please affirm your 10 11 votes? [Chorus of ayes.] 12 MS. VIETTI-COOK: That's all I have. 13 14 CHAIRMAN MESERVE: Good.
