SECRETARY VIETTI-COOK: The Commission is being 6 7 asked to act on a final rule amending 10 CFR Part 26 to 8 ensure compatibility with changes in the Department of 9 Health and Human Services Guidelines, to reduce regulatory 10 burden in some areas; to clarify original intent of the 11 rule; and improve overall program effectiveness and efficiency. 12 In addition, the rule also grants a December 30th, 13 14 1993 petition for rulemaking submitted by Virginia Power, by 15 changing the audit frequency of fitness for duty programs 16 from one year to three years. 17 The Commission has voted to approve the publication and implementation of this final rule, subject 18 19 to the comments and changes provided. Commissioner Diaz disapproved, in part, because he 20 did not believe the worthwhile changes passed the backfit 21 22 test. Would you please affirm your votes. [Vote affirmed 5 to zero.] 23 SECRETARY VIETTI-COOK: That's all I have. 24 CHAIRMAN MESERVE: Very good. 25
