NRC to Discuss Limited Hearing Opportunity for Vogtle New Reactors

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will hold a meeting Oct. 30 in Waynesboro, Ga., to discuss how the public will have an opportunity to ask for a hearing prior to nuclear fuel being loaded at the under-construction Vogtle Units 3 and 4.

The meeting will run from 6-7 p.m. in Room 163 at the Augusta Technical College, 216 Highway 24 S in Waynesboro. The staff will discuss the hearing opportunity related to inspections, tests, analyses and acceptance criteria that verify the Vogtle reactors have been built in accordance with their combined licenses and will operate safely. The staff will hold an open house before the meeting, starting at 4:30 p.m., for informal discussions with the public.
