NOTES

- On page 126 and in Appendix E (Operating US Nuclear RTRs) the correction to the license number for the University of Texas (Austin, TX). It currently reads R-92 (which represents an old decommissioned reactor) it should read: R-129 -- Noted by University of Texas faculty (11/30/11).
- On page 20 and in Appendix J footnote on Taiwan, China is missing. Should read that the nuclear share data in Taiwan, China is not listed.
- On page 25 correct name for INES should read as The International Nuclear and Radiological Events Scale
- On page 32 NRC report, Vermont Yankee (VY) is listed as having being issued an “operating license” in 1973, this is an error VY received its operating license on March 21, 1972 and it began commercial operation on Nov. 30, 1972.
