Subject: REGION II RESPONSE TO HURRICANE WILMA

The Region II office secured from Monitoring Mode and deactivated its Incident Response Center at 1:15 p.m. on October 24, 2005. Hurricane Wilma has moved past the Turkey Point site and storm damage to the site was minimal.

An ongoing dialogue was maintained with the State throughout this event. The Federal Emergency Management Agency Region IV also activated their Regional Resource Coordination Center to monitor the hurricane.
