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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, JULY 11-13

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting July 11-13, in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, a revised draft NRC staff report on demonstrating the feasibility and reliability of operator manual actions in response to fire. In addition, the committee will discuss dissimilar metal weld issues. The ACRS advises the Commission on licensing and operation of nuclear power plants and related safety issues.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike.
