NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET DEC. 6-8 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting Dec. 6-8 in Rockville, Md., to discuss, among other items, state-of-the-art reactor consequence analysis, the agency's safety research program and the extended power uprate application for the Susquehanna nuclear power plant.

Portions of this meeting may be closed to protect information that is proprietary and are identified in the agenda.

The ACRS advises the Commission on licensing and operation of nuclear power plants and related safety issues.

The meeting will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike.
