SUBJECT: OPEN ITEMS IN THE DRAFT SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT  
RELATED TO LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

During the 565<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards, September 10-12, 2009, the Committee discussed its existing policy, regarding license renewal applications, that the draft Safety Evaluation Report (SER) submitted to the ACRS for interim review should not have more than 10 open items. This policy was established to preclude having subsequent Subcommittee meetings to discuss the resolution of a large number of open items and to minimize the full Committee time in discussing their resolution. The Committee would like to reemphasize its policy since there are new staff and management who may not be aware of this policy.
