SUBJECT: POINT BEACH UNIT 1 DECLARES NOTIFICATION OF UNUSUAL EVENT DUE TO LOSS OF OFFSITE POWER

DESCRIPTION: On November 27, 2011, at 2:38 a.m. (CST), Point Beach Nuclear Plant Unit 1 declared a Notification of Unusual Event following the loss of offsite power to both Unit 1 safety-related buses for greater than 15 minutes and the start of the emergency diesel generators to provide alternate power to those buses. The Unusual Event was terminated at 7:00 a.m., when the licensee regained offsite power and subsequently shut down the emergency diesel generators.

The loss of offsite power occurred during an attempt by the licensee to return a Unit 1 transformer to service. This transformer supplies offsite power to Unit 1's safety-related buses. Plant equipment operated during the loss of offsite power via the emergency diesel generators, as designed. At the time of the Unusual Event, Unit 1 had been shut down for a refueling outage since October 3rd and Unit 2 was operating at 100 percent power.

The licensee is in the process of determining the exact cause of the Unit 1 loss of offsite power.

The NRC Senior Resident Inspector responded to the site shortly after the Unusual Event was declared and is continuing to monitor the utility's inspection activities. Regional electrical engineering inspectors are also looking into the issue.

The State of Wisconsin was notified. The information in this preliminary notification has been reviewed with licensee management.
