OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON DRAFT REVISIONS TO SA-1101, "MONTHLY U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION, ORGANIZATION OF AGREEMENT STATES, AND CONFERENCE OF RADIATION CONTROL PROGRAM DIRECTORS, INC. TELECONFERENCE" (FSME-13-014)

Purpose: To provide the Agreement States with the opportunity to comment on proposed revisions to the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-1101, "Monthly U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Organization of Agreement States, and Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc. Teleconference."

Background: FSME SA-1101 was last revised in February 2009. Draft revisions to the procedure were prepared to update the procedure based on current practice.

Discussion: Enclosed for your review and comment are the draft revisions to FSME SA-1101. FSME SA-1101 describes the process used by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission to coordinate, notify, and administer monthly teleconferences between itself, the Organization of Agreement States (OAS), and the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc.
