AAF International ("AAF") submits this letter to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") as a follow-up to its previous Part 21 interim notification of a possible deviation or defect in nuclear qualified High Efficiency Particulate Air ("HEPA") filters manufactured by AAF, dated March 18, 2013. This follow-up letter is submitted in furtherance of AAF's previous letter and pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR Part 21.

In its letter dated March 18, 2013, AAF informed the NRC that AAF has undertaken an investigation into a test failure of two (2) nuclear qualified HEPA filters. As of the date of the previous letter, AAF believed its investigation and final report would be completed no later than April 15, 2013. However, due to the testing schedule required for the nuclear HEPA filters, it now appears that AAF's investigation will not conclude prior to April 15, 2013. AAF anticipates that its final report will be filed on or before May 3, 2013.
