OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON DRAFT NRC REGULATORY ISSUE SUMMARY REPORTING TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING TEMPORARY JOB SITES TO THE NATIONAL SOURCE TRACKING SYSTEM (FSME-13-051)

**Purpose:** To provide the Agreement States with the opportunity to comment on the proposed U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commissions (NRC) Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) Reporting Transactions Involving Temporary Job Sites to the National Source Tracking System (NSTS).

**Background:** The issue of reporting requirements associated with transferring nationally tracked sources to a temporary job site is not addressed in the NRC regulations. The issue was addressed in the supplementary information in both the proposed rule and the final rule for the NSTS. The enclosed draft RIS presents clarifying information for the reporting requirements when transferring nationally tracked sources to a temporary job site.
