**SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INTERIM 10 CFR PART 21 REPORT REGARDING DEVIATIONS

By letter dated January 21, 2014, CB&I submitted an interim report in accordance with 10 CFR 21.21 pertaining to the identification of deviations associated with sub-modules supplied for AP1000 CA20 module assembly. The sub-modules are being supplied as basic components. The report stated that evaluation of reportability in accordance with 10 CFR Part 21 was not completed within the 60-day evaluation period due to the need to perform qualification of the welding process that was used. The report also stated that it was expected that the evaluation of these conditions would be completed by March 21, 2014.

Evaluation of the conditions identified in the January 21, 2014, interim report were completed by March 21, 2014. The conditions were determined to be not reportable in accordance with 10 CFR Part 21.
