OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED REVISION TO OFFICE OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL SAFETY AND SAFEGUARDS PROCEDURE SL-200, "MAINTAINING TRANSPORTATION DESIGNEE CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL (10 CFR PARTS 37, 71 AND 73)" (STC-16-066)

Purpose: To provide an opportunity to comment on the proposed revision to the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SL-200, "Maintaining Transportation Designee Contact Information for Advance Notification of Transportation of Certain Radioactive Material (Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Parts 37, 71 and 73)."

Background: This procedure is being revised to include changes in process since the last publication in 2009, including Tribal officials' acknowledgement of the completion of Safeguards Information training by Tribal transportation designees, an annual validation by NMSS staff of the contact information for State and Tribal transportation designees on https://scp.nrc.gov/special/designee.pdf, and NMSS records management of correspondence from States, territories, and Tribes authorizing individuals to be designated as transportation designees for advance notification of spent fuel and certain nuclear waste shipments.

Discussion: Enclosed for your review and comment is a proposed revision to NMSS Procedure SL-200. The current draft revision is not in red line strikeout format because it has been significantly revised and reformatted. Due to the high number of NRC-related documents currently being reviewed by the States, the comment* period for SL-200 is 60 days from the date of this letter.
