ACCEPTANCE: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Brachytherapy, Gamma Knife, and Other Medical Uses (H-313) course. This course is scheduled to be presented August 13-17, 2018, at the Advanced Health Education Center (AHEC). The AHEC is located at 8502 Tybor Drive, Houston, Texas 77074. <u>COURSE</u>: Please see our Web site, https://scp.nrc.gov/training.html for the Tentative Course Schedule and note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 13, 2018 and ends at 12 noon on Friday, August 17, 2018.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, August 12, 2018 and depart on Friday, August 17, 2018. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Due to the distance to the Houston airports from the training site and potential ticketing and security lines at the airports themselves, students should allow at least two hours between the class end time and their scheduled departure. Please select a fully refundable Government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to credit card ending 2835. If the need arises and you must make a change, please contact Karen Meyer at 301-415-0113.

Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, Astrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov, no later than Friday, August 3rd. Please request and do not exceed the Federal per diem of \$121 for your hotel. The meals and incidentals per diem for Houston, Texas is \$59. The first and last days of travel are calculated at 75 percent (i.e., \$48.25). Rental cars are not reimbursable. If you are authorized to drive your personal vehicle, mileage reimbursement is 54.5 cents per mile. A complimentary shuttle is available for transportation between the hotel and the training center for individuals staying at the hotels listed below. Please contact the front desk for details upon arrival. Those students who elect to stay at an alternate hotel will be responsible for their own transportation between the hotel and the training center.
