INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>: Individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the Brachytherapy, Gamma Knife and Other Uses (H-313) course. This course is scheduled to be presented January 13-17, 2020, at the Advanced Health Education Center (AHEC). The AHEC is located at 8502 Tybor Drive, Houston, Texas 77074. The facility's telephone number is (713) 772-0157.

<u>COURSE</u>: Please see our Web site, <u>https://scp.nrc.gov/training.html</u> for the Tentative Course Schedule and note that the course begins at 8:00 a.m. local time on Monday, January 13, 2020, and ends at 12 noon local time on Friday, January 17, 2020.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: Please plan to arrive on Sunday, January 12th, and depart on Friday, January 17th. Please plan to attend the course through the stated end time of 12 noon. Due to the distance to the Houston airports from the training site and potential ticketing and security lines at the airports themselves, students should allow at least two hours between the class end time and their scheduled departure. If there are no flights available that would allow you to arrive home before midnight on Friday, January 17th, you may elect to depart on Saturday, January 18th. In this event, NRC will provide reimbursement for hotel on Friday night and per diem on Saturday, January 18th. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at (844) 244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to the NRC credit card. If the need arises and you must make a change or cancel, contact Karen Meyer at 301-415-0113.

Please complete the Travel Information and Estimated Expenses Form which will be provided to you in a separate communication and submit to <u>AStrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov</u>, at your earliest opportunity, but no later than Friday, December 27th. The per diem for Houston, Texas is \$125 hotel and \$61 meals and incidentals. The first and last day of travel is calculated at 75 percent. If you are authorized to drive, the Federal mileage reimbursement is 58 cents per mile. Rental cars are not reimbursable. A complimentary shuttle is available for transportation between the hotel and the training center for individuals staying at the hotels listed below. Please contact the front desk for details upon arrival. Those students who elect to stay at an alternate hotel will be responsible for their own transportation between the hotel and the training center. You are asked to reserve your hotel through El Sol Travel – doing so will provide you with various benefits. *Please note that the Crown Plaza Suites is the preferred hotel*.
