NOTIFICATION OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON SA-900, TERMINATION OF URANIUM MILLING LICENSES IN AGREEMENT STATES (STC-22-060)

**Purpose**: This communication serves to inform the National Materials Program (NMP) community that the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) State Agreements (SA) procedure SA-900, *Termination of Uranium Milling Licenses in Agreement States*, has been revised and to solicit comments from the NMP community prior to SA-900 being issued.

**Background**: SA-900, *Termination of Uranium Milling Licenses in Agreement States*, describes the review process for making the determination that all applicable standards and requirements have been met prior to Agreement State uranium milling license termination, as required by 10 CFR 150.15a(a) and Section 274c of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (Act).

**Discussion**: This letter notifies the NMP community that SA-900 has been revised and issued for comment. Comments are due by 60 days from date of letter. Once the comments have been resolved, the procedure will be finalized and issued. The revised procedure is being issued to the NMP community to solicit comments before finalizing SA-900<sup>1</sup>.
