SUBJECT: UPDATE -CALLAWAY RESTART FOLLOWING PLANT AUTOMATIC REACTOR TRIP DUE TO MAIN GENERATOR FAULT AND SHUTDOWN GREATER THAN 72 HOURS

DESCRIPTION:

Callaway Plant was restarted on August 2, 2021. Callaway plant had been shut down since December 24, 2020 due to an automatic reactor trip from 90 percent power because of a problem with the main generator, a non-safety system.

The licensee made repairs to the main generator. Plant operators commenced a reactor startup and the reactor was made critical on August 2, 2021. The unit was synchronized to the electrical grid on August 4, 2021, and reached full power on August 8, 2021, and remains at full power. The resident inspectors and one additional inspector were on site and monitored portions of the repair and startup activities.

On August 9, 2021, the licensee issued a press release to inform the public that the Callaway Plant outage was complete, and the plant was returned to full power.

The State of Missouri has been notified.
