

Fee Schedules: Fee Recovery for Fiscal Year 2024: Proposed Rule; 10 CFR Parts 2, 15, 37, 73, 110, 140, 170, and 171 [NRC-2022-0046; RIN 3150-AK74]

On February 20, 2024, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a proposed rule in the *Federal Register* ([89 FR 12759](#)) proposing to amend the licensing, inspection, special project, and annual fees charged to its applicants and licensees. The proposed amendments are necessary to comply with the Nuclear Energy Innovation and Modernization Act, which requires the NRC to recover, to the maximum extent practicable, approximately 100 percent of its annual budget less certain amounts excluded from this fee recovery requirement. Comments are requested by March 21, 2024.
