PURPOSE: To conduct transcribed public meetings to provide members of the public with the opportunity to provide their comments on what environmental issues the NRC should consider during its review of the license renewal application for Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1. This meeting is being conducted as part of the scoping process outlined in 10 CFR Part 51 to support development of an environmental impact statement in support of the application. ML020180057 and ML020230166). This is a Category 3 meeting at which the staff is seeking public input concerning the draft EIS.

Both formal sessions will be preceded by an informal "open house" beginning one hour prior to each session for those who wish to attend. The "open house" will provide members of the public with an opportunity to talk informally "one-on-one" with NRC staff.
