Comments: According to regulation, "A civil monetary penalty imposed under Section 234 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, or any other statute within the jurisdiction of the Commission that provides for the imposition of a civil penalty in an amount equal to the amount set forth in Section 234, may not exceed \$120,000 for each violation. If any violation is a continuing one, each day of such violation shall constitute a separate violation for the purpose of computing the applicable civil penalty."

Discrimination cases that constitute 'continuing violations', should be penalized as a 'separate violation' for the purpose of computing the applicable civil penalty.
