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## NRC Issues Final Environmental Impact Statement for Perry Nuclear Power Plant License Renewal

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued its <u>final supplemental environmental impact statement</u> for renewing the operating license of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1, 35 miles northeast of Cleveland, Ohio.

The operating license for Perry Unit 1, a boiling-water reactor, expires Nov. 7, 2026. The plant owner, Vistra Operations Company LLC, submitted the license renewal application on July 3, 2023. The NRC's review of the application covers both safety and environmental impacts. The NRC's Safety Evaluation Report for Perry's license renewal is expected to be completed soon. The agency will consider the safety and environmental reports in making a final decision on extending Perry's license for an additional 20 years.
