The amendments are in response to your application dated August 6, 1999, as supplemented on November 15, 1999.

The amendments revise Technical Specification 3/4.4.6, "Vacuum Relief" to remove specific operability requirements related to position indication for the suppression chamber-drywell vacuum breakers. The amendments also reformat the action statement for inoperable vacuum breakers, increase the surveillance interval for verifying that the vacuum breakers are closed, and delete the requirement to verify that the manual isolation valves are closed for an inoperable and open vacuum breaker.
