Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

This is in response to your petition, received today, requesting that Northeast Utilities be directed to suspend operation of the Millstone Units 2 and 3 facilities.

Over the last three years the NRC, in conjunction with the nuclear industry, has developed a comprehensive set of procedures intended to address and minimize the potential that public health and safety concerns might be created at NRC-licensed facilities because of Y2K issues. The licensee for the Millstone facilities has informed the Commission that all safety-related systems are Y2K compliant, and, as a consequence, these facilities can be safely shut down should the need arise.

Your petition does not otherwise present any safety issues which would warrant the action you request and, accordingly, your petition is denied.

For your further information, I am enclosing a copy of recent correspondence from the Chairman to Senator Christopher Dodd and Senator Robert F. Bennett addressing Y2K matters.
