We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence Dated december 17, 1999, transmitting the FEMA evaluation report for the October 5, 1999 Biennial Emergency Preparedness Exercise at the Kewaunee Nuclear Plant.
