
Reference: Letter from J. P. Dimmette, Jr. (ComEd) SVP-99-170, to USNRC, dated August 13, 1999 "Relief Requests CR-25, CR-26, CR-27, CR-28, CR-30, PR-11, PR-12 and PR-13.

Relief request CR-30, contained within the Referenced letter, requested relief from performing a VT-1 visual examination of bolted connections. The relief request proposed performing a general visual examination in lieu of the VT-1 visual examination.

On January 4, 2000, during discussions with the NRC, the NRC requested information related to the Corporate General Visual Inspection procedure SPP GV-2 "Inservice Inspection". The question was whether the Corporate Responsible Engineer was a Registered Professional Engineer. ComEd has confirmed that the Corporate Responsible Engineer is a Registered Professional Engineer. ComEd will also ensure that future changes to this procedure will be approved by a Registered Professional Engineer.
