Gentlemen:

In a letter dated October 22, 1999, the NRC described arrangements for the administration of licensing examinations for Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company at the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2, during the weeks of February 14, 2000, and February 21, 2000. The NRC requested that CP&L submit preliminary reactor operator and senior reactor operator (SRO) license applications, medical certifications, and waiver requests at least 30 days before the first examination date.

Enclosed are draft, unsigned personal qualification statements for each of the applicants who are scheduled to participate in the upcoming licensing examinations. Also enclosed is a signed NRC Form 396, "Certification of Medical Examination By Facility Licensee" for each of these applicants.

An examination waiver request is included to support the issuance of an SRO license for an applicant who was previously licensed (Docket No. 55-20062) at the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant. The individual participated in Licensed Operator Continuing Training as a non-licensed Shift Technical Advisor and was current with the requalification requirements as of May 1999. This was followed by his enrollment in the current Hot License Class in May 1999. In accordance with 10 CFR 55.47, CP&L will be requesting a waiver for the written examination, simulator examination, and walk-through based on the information included in the attached NRC Form 398. This waiver request has been discussed with Mr. George Hopper of your staff.

CP&L requests that the enclosed information be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6), since disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
