Dear Mr. Reyes,

As you are aware, the situation regarding the presence of depleted uranium and possible radiation contamination in the island of Vieques has become a concern, not only of the Health Department, but also of all the population of Puerto Rico, due to the hazards it may pose to the public health.

In the letter sent by Mrs. Shirley Ann Jackson (June 29th, 199) to the Legislature of the Virgin Islands it was stated that the NRC would conduct an independent inspection of the Navy's recovery activities and the corrective actions taken by said military corps. Nevertheless, we have had no further official knowledge of the results of these actions.

As the Secretary of Health of Puerto Rico my purpose with this letter is to urge from the NRC, as the Regulatory Agency that it is, the prompt intervention in this matter. We will greatly appreciate that you keep us informed of the results of any action you consider to take in this situation. You can rely in our unconditional support and cooperation.
