COURSE: The course will be conducted beginning at 8:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. each day except for Friday which will end at 2:00 p.m. Please refer to AHEC's Webpage at URL: http://www.AHEConline.com for hotel information and transportation between the hotel and the AHEC. Click on General Information.

LODGING: You should plan to arrive on Sunday March 12, 2000 and depart on Friday, March 17, 2000. Some hotels offer transportation to and from the AHEC. Participants must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Individuals should request a State or government employee rate at the hotel.
