Enclosed is an application for a license (XSNM03137), recently received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, for the export of natural and low-enriched uranium hexafluoride in the form of heels in cylinders being returned to various EURATOM companies for storage and cleaning purposes.

After the required waiting period, we will issue the requested license to authorize the export of uranium hexafluoride heels in cylinders to EURATOM countries until 10 CFR 110 is amended to permit such exports under the General License in Sections 110.21 and 110.22.
